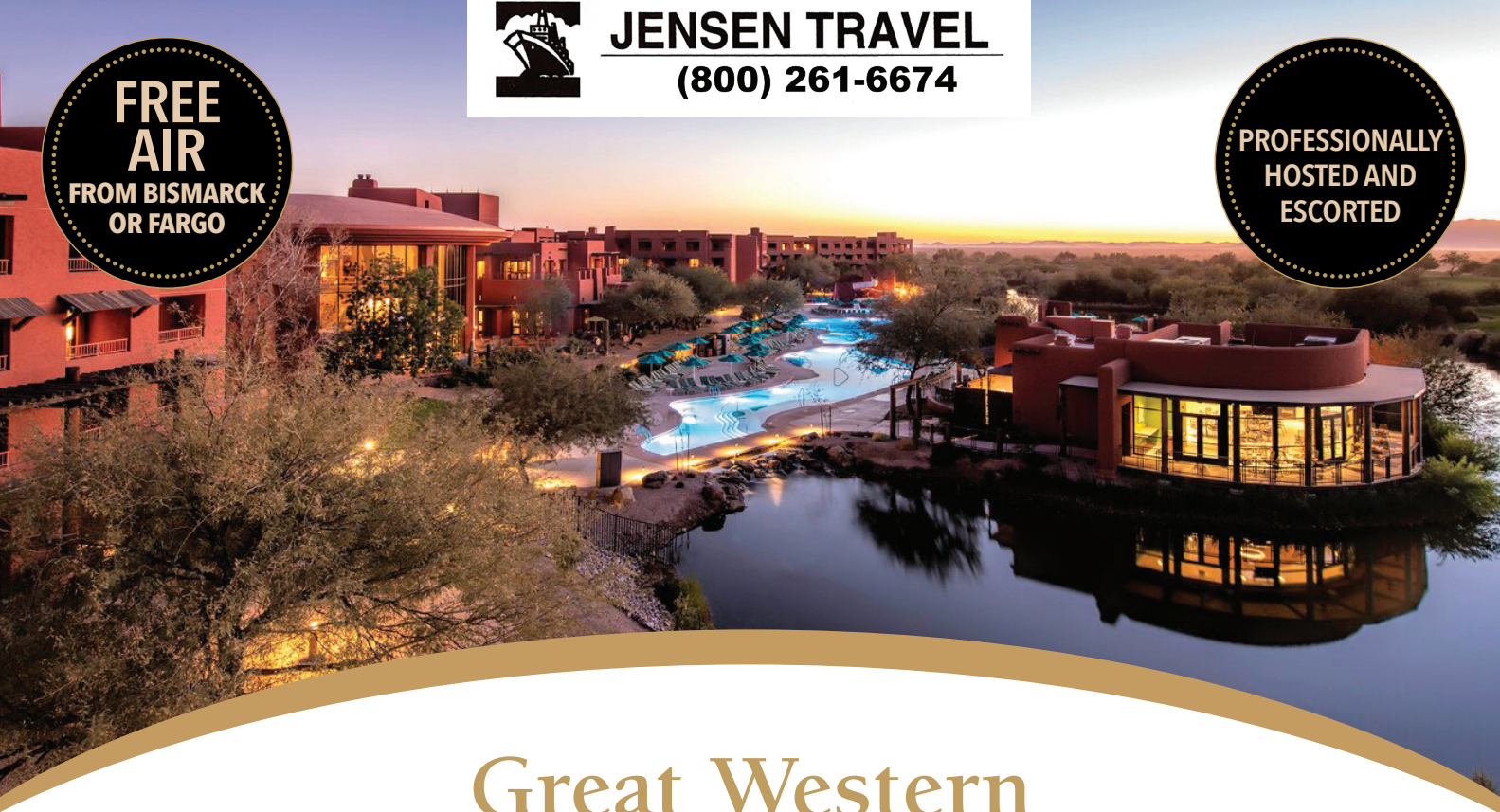

DAY 6 Another Day at the Ranch: Enjoy another day at the ranch and another day of included riding. There is also a host of other activities available for a nominal fee. The Arizona desert is a perfect place to practice your shooting skills in a fun and safe environment. A selection of Western style guns are available to choose from including replicas of Wyatt Earp and Doc Holiday pistols. There are also archery lessons, fat tire biking and even rock climbing. For something relaxing, try the 27-seat theater and catch a favorite movie on the widescreen. On most evenings after dinner events such as a moonlight bonfire with a cowboy singer, line dancing lessons and trick roping will round out the evening. **Meals: B, L, D**

DAY 7 Travel Home: After breakfast, your adventure comes to a close today with a group transfer to Phoenix’ Sky Harbor International Airport for flights out after 1:00 p.m. **Meal: B**
