### **DAYS 1 & 2 Journey to Australia**

Depart the USA on your transpacific flight to Cairns, Australia, crossing the International Date Line en route.

### **DAY 3 Cairns, Australia**

Upon arrival, you'll be met by a Mayflower Cruises & Tours representative and transferred to your hotel, with a panoramic tour en route. The remainder of the day is at leisure.

### **DAY 4 Cairns**

### **DAY 6 Cairns – Sydney**

After a morning flight to Sydney, depart on a tour of this remarkable city built around one of the most spectacular harbors in the world. ### **DAY 9 Sydney – Melbourne**

# POST-TRIP NORTH ISLAND OPTIONAL EXTENSION

Continue your Kiwi experience on New Zealand’s North Island

**DAY 16 Christchurch – Rotorua:** Depart Christchurch airport for Rotorua. Upon arrival, discovery begins with a visit to Te Puia, center for Maori culture and geothermal wonders. Experience local culture with demonstrations of stone and wood carving and weaving by students of the Maori Arts & Crafts Institute. See huts and meeting houses, important components of local architectural heritage. The largest active geyser in the southern hemisphere also resides in the park. After the visit, check in to the hotel.

**DAY 17 Rotorua:** Begin the day with a visit to the Agrodome to attend a “sheep show” and see the sheep dogs at work, watch a sheep-shearing demonstration, and pet baby farm animals. This afternoon, visit the Kiwi Hatchery Aotearoa to learn about New Zealand’s national icon and endangered species, the Kiwi. The guided visit explores egg incubation systems, hatching

techniques and chick rearing. Travel to this evening’s included dinner via aerial gondola to the restaurant perched atop Mount Ngongotaha. A unique venue, locally grown food, and spectacular views await! **Meals: B, D**

**DAY 18 Rotorua – Hobbiton – Auckland:** Depart Rotorua by coach to Auckland. En-route, visit Hobbiton for a real-life Middle Earth experience from *Lord of the Rings* and *The Hobbit* films. See the famous movie set and where Frodo’s adventure began. Continue to Auckland with the remainder of the day at leisure. **Meal: B**

**DAY 19 Auckland:** Begin the day with a city tour as your driver/guide shows you the highlights of this cosmopolitan city. ## Booking Conditions

**Payments:** All deposits and final payments can be made by check or credit card. We accept the following credit cards: Visa, MasterCard and Discover.

**Prices Subject to Change:** We reserve the right to vary itineraries and prices and substitute facilities, hotels or events of equal or better quality if necessary.

**Guaranteed Share Program for Single Travelers:** If you are traveling alone and would like a roommate for cost savings, let us know at the time of booking your reservation. Travelers must be non-smokers, cannot use a medical sleeping device or have specific needs like Handicapped room etc. to be eligible. Participants will be paired with another traveler of the same gender at the twin rate. If no roommate is available, you will get a single room at the twin rate. Guaranteed share reservations are available up to 180 days prior to tour departure and based on availability.

**Roommate Cancellation:** If you are booked as a "twin" and your roommate cancels their reservation, and you cannot find another roommate, you may either travel as a guaranteed share (see above) or travel as a single and pay the single supplement.

**Health and Walking on Tour:** Some sites visited have limited motorcoach access and may involve considerable walking, stairs or inclines. Travelers should be in reasonably good health. Some programs include destinations in higher elevations that may have varying effects on individual travelers. Tour Managers and Coach Drivers cannot lift or assist travelers into transportation vehicles. Mayflower Cruises & Tours requires that persons requiring assistance be accompanied by a companion who is capable of and totally responsible for providing the assistance.

**Revision Fees:** A fee of \$25 per person per transaction will be charged for any changes, revisions or alterations made to your reservation after confirmation.

**Luggage Handling:** The tour cost includes portage for one average size suitcase. A charge of \$5.00 per hotel will be collected by the Tour Manager for each additional piece of luggage that you bring.

**Travel Documents:** Your travel documents will be in your possession approximately 14 days prior to departure. Documents include tour itinerary, departure and arrival information and times, hotel information, clothing suggestions, baggage tags, plus any helpful hints.
