Your Tour Manager will make suggestions for things to do in this city of *Midnight in the Garden of Good and Evil* and *Forrest Gump* fame. Tonight, the evening is also free for you to uncover some of Savannah's secrets on your own. **(Breakfast)**

DAY 5 Jekyll Island: Today, travel down the coast to the southernmost island of Georgia's Golden Isles, Jekyll Island.
