## Day 2 Athens (Piraeus), Greece

## Day 3 Transit the Corinth Canal - Itea, Greece

A narrow waterway that connects the Gulf of Corinth with the Saronic Gulf in Greece, the Corinth Canal is a 19th-century feat of engineering. As your luxury yacht passes through this slender canal, appreciate the stunning views of the soaring, ochre-coloured cliffs. After transiting the Corinth Canal, you'll then arrive in the picturesque town of Itea, gateway to the ancient ruins of Delphi, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the most important archaeological and mythological areas in Greece. ## Day 4 Katakolon, Greece

Located on the western shores of the Peloponnese peninsula, the small seaside town of Katakolon is best known as the gateway to the ancient archaeological site of Olympia, the birthplace of the Olympic Games. Arguably the most celebrated sacred place of Ancient Greece, at this UNESCO World Heritage-listed site, explore these important ruins, which include the Temple of Zeus and original Olympic stadium. **Meals: B, L, D**

## Day 5 Chania, Crete, Greece

Welcome to Chania, a charming coastal town located on the northwest coast of the lovely Greek island of Crete. Chania is known for its picturesque Venetian harbour, narrow winding streets, and vibrant atmosphere. The town boasts a rich history that is evident in its eclectic mix of architectural styles, including Venetian, Ottoman, and Greek influences. Here, spend your day relaxing on one of the beautiful beaches, or exploring historical sites such as ancient ruins and museums. **Meals: B, L, D**

## Day 6 Santorini, Greece

One of the most world's photogenic islands, Santorini presents a spectacular destination, iconic for its whitewashed buildings clustered across soaring cliffs that overlook the azure Aegean Sea. This hugely popular Greek island is also renowned for its volcanic landscapes and black sand beaches. The picturesque main town, Fira, dramatically rests on the edge of a caldera cliff, revealing jaw-dropping vistas, while Oia, one of Santorini's charming traditional villages, is especially worth a visit for its quaint narrow streets, trademark blue-domed churches and legendary sunsets. **Meals: B, L, D**

## Day 7 Mykonos, Greece

Today, you'll visit another equally beautiful and popular Greek Island, Mykonos. The allure of this world-famous island lies in its blend of traditional Greek culture and cosmopolitan flair. ## Day 9 Cruise the Dardanelles - Kepez, Turkey

The Dardanelles is a stunning strait that connects the Aegean Sea to the Sea of Marmara, a small inland sea within the borders of Turkey. As you cruise through the strait on board your luxury yacht, seize the opportunity to learn all about the region's rich history, including its importance in various conflicts throughout the centuries, as well as admire breathtaking views of the surrounding landscape.
